The number of PCOC providers has declined from the hundreds to twenty over the last year. CPS remains a leading Canadian provider, the only one with NASBLA and USCG endorsement.

The Canadian Safe Boating Council, an alliance of members promoting safe and responsible boating, has created SmartBoater.ca. The website is a one stop place for recreational boaters, the media and boating educators to obtain information about safe and responsible boating. As the Chief said, "It's worth a visit for the informative, educational and relevant presentations."

**PCOC Education & Testing
Your Assistance in Recalling Old Tests is
Urgently Needed!**

For the past dozen years CPS and the Kitchener-Waterloo Squadron has been providing the education and testing necessary to obtain Pleasure Craft Operating Cards (PCOC). The education was based on Boat Pro & Boating courses or their predecessors. The testing was based on CPS's PCOC tests.

Effective April 15th, 2011, all providers of PCOC must meet new Standards under Transport Canada's Program. The Program specifies that examinations will be created by Transport Canada. CPS, and particularly our Squadron, must follow the Testing Regime in the distribution, recall and destruction of examinations.

This is where your assistance is required. *All copies of old tests in any form; hard copy or electronic, need to be located, recalled and destroyed. All instructors, proctors, invigilators, and registered providers associated with the Squadron need to locate any tests they may have at home or on their computers.* Delivery of tests or declarations of destruction will be required by Glenn Shugg on May 15th, 2011.

Twelve Years is a long period to recall who has been involved in PCOC testing. Also, a lot of records may be accumulated. Yet, our Squadron must return to CPS Headquarters in May 2011 a declaration that old test have been destroyed.
